

PART V - DECISION AND FOLLOW-UP

Upon receiving the completed medical form from the attending physician, the state officer in charge of medical exemption requests will re-circulate the combined forms among the Executive Council members for a final decision. Again, a two-thirds or greater vote will be required for acceptance of this medical exemption. The President of the Executive Council will notify the pitcher, in writing, of the Council's decision and (if granted) the pitcher may then, and only then, begin pitching in NHPA sanctioned events from the shorter distance. The pitcher must also notify the State Secretary of the date that he will begin pitching from this shorter distance. Re-qualification at this shorter distance may also be necessary (see Rules/Bylaws). Although it is expected that this will be a long-term exemption, the State Executive Council reserves the right to review and/or withdraw the medical exemption at any time.
